The Chairman presided. The Treasurer gave his report which was approved. ^{There was a bank balance of £58.63.} As there was a lack of support at the Meeting the Chairman asked the Committee if they were willing to serve for a further year, which they agreed to do.

It was reported that the bus-shelter roof was in need of repair, also the hedge round the White Cottages needed trimming. The Committee undertook these jobs.

Miss B. Ward, tenant of No. 1 White Cottages has undertaken the clearing of the bus shelter for a further year. Mr. J. Paulin proposed that she should be given one month's free rent for doing this work. This was seconded by Mr. G. Saul.

The plans submitted by R.D.C. for outline planning permission for a dwelling at "Hindlea" Broughton for Mr. & Mrs. Burr were discussed and the following observations made.

1. The plans submitted showed only one hedge on the outer side of the "right of way" path, where in fact there is a hedge on either side.
2. The committee asked if this "right of way" is correctly shown as being on Mr. Burr's property as no maps were available to clarify this.
3. The Committee objected to the plans as the street blind access is only 8 ft. wide, & they considered this as hazardous.
4. The Clerk was instructed to report these

observations to Ryedale D.C.

1. The Chairman read the minutes of the last meeting which were approved and signed.
2. Plans had been received from Ryedale D.C. for the observations of the Meeting for the construction of 3 dwellings and garages at Dobson's Yard, Breedycroft Lane for P. D. Ingram. These plans were discussed, and no objections were made to them.
3. A letter had been sent from the Chairman of Ryedale D.C. re his Charity Appeal for "St. Catherine's Hospice." It was unanimously decided to send a donation of £5. to this cause.
4. A report was received of damage to the bus shelter roof. The Committee members undertook to do the repair work.
5. A local children's Club had been formed in the district by the Rev. J. Martin for the children in the Parish of Amotherby. It was decided to support this by sending a donation of £10, as this Club was of great benefit to the children living in Broughton.
6. Complaints have been received about the narrowness of Breedycroft Lane. The Clerk was instructed to write to the Highways and Byways Dept. asking for the construction of a footpath for the following reasons:-
 1. The Lane is not wide enough to allow 2 cars to pass.

2. If the buildings in Dobson's Tard are built the Lane will have increased traffic including builders lorries etc..
3. Pedestrians now have to step up on to the grass verges if a car vehicle comes down the Lane and these are high on both sides of the Lane.
4. In winter these grass verges are used by people exercising horses and become slippery and dangerous.
5. One accident has already occurred when a lady over 70 yrs. slipped and sprained both her ankles. It was felt a footpath should be constructed to prevent further accidents and inconvenience to pedestrians.
7. No further business was to hand, so the Meeting was closed by the Chairman.
