5. The Bus Shelter is in need of repair. Mr. J. Paulin +
 Mr. R. Lind agreed to see what was needed + to carry
 out the work.
6. Concern was expressed re the junction of the road
 from Broughton village and the B 4057 where the
 visibility is poor. A suggestion was made that a
 good reduction of the hedge or chip bank removed
 would solve the problem. It was decided to contact
 Mr. I. Hamilton about this possibility.
7. Mr. R. Lind suggested purchasing £2 commemorative
 coins for the school children in the Village to celebrate
 V.E. Day. It was hoped a "street party" could be
 arranged by the residents of Manor Park to present
 these. Mr. R. Lind agreed to contact the residents.
8. A "Neighbourhood Watch" Scheme is being
 organised for the Village, whereby the co-ordinators
 need a "Touch" telephone. 2 of the co-ordinators
 do not have these + it was agreed that if B.T.

would not agree to exchange their previous phones free of charge the Parish Meeting would meet the cost.

1. Outline Planning Application for Residential Development (Site Area 0.156 HA) to land north-west of Oak Farm Broughton. - received from Ryedale District Council, as registered 31.07.95.
2. An informal meeting was held to discuss these plans, as strong protests had been voiced by the residents near the proposed site. After discussion the committee was divided 50/50. for & against the plans. It was understood that a petition was being circulated in the village. The Chairman wrote to Ryedale District Council expressing our views.
3. Revised Plans were received, dated Sept '95.
4. A Site Meeting was arranged by R.D.C. for Monday, 20th Nov 1995 at 2.00pm to which the Chairman of Broughton Parish Meeting was invited to attend. Mr. J. Paulin (Chairman), Mr. R. Lind (Treasurer) attended this meeting.
