Recent circulars and correspondence were presented to the meeting by the clerk. The main issues were as follows, a letter from Northern Electric regarding next years maintenance scheme. The meeting decided that the 'two visits' per annum most appropriate.

A letter from Swinton & Broughton Cricket Club asking for a possible donation to assist them to buy basics and put towards a scoring mechanism. After discussion, it was agreed that the meeting would donate £100 to the club.

Another request came from the short mat bowls club which uses the sports hall and consists of several Broughton parishioners. Their need was for equipment on which expensive bowling mats could be stored between games. The club had purchased the material from which they had made one mat store but they did not have the resource for others. After a lengthy explanation a further £100 was donated to purchase the materials. Members of the meeting did express concern at the amount of financial help being directed to the sports hall. However the meeting was happy to assist the activity groups which involved Broughton people.
